1. BMCC 10th year BBQ: Brief event details

- BC confirmed that the BMCC 10th year BBQ is planned to be held on Saturday 24th July 2010, at The Trigger Pond, Bucknell.
- Discussed price of tickets being around £5 per head or £12 per family, although this would need to be confirmed with the venue. BC to investigate further and feedback.
- Raffle to be held/arranged.

2. Clubs drinks bottles: Update

- These have been finally finished and artwork files sent for production.
- Agreed to run with the 500ml version first due to the setup cost for the print screens on both bottle sizes. If these 500ml bottles sell well. We will look into getting the larger 750ml produced.
- Have agreed to get a split colour base order, some white and clear bottles are being produced.
- Selling price? £0.00 (TBC)
- Philip (Hendrick) has agreed to help distribute bottles once we have them in stock.

3. Membership fees 2011

- Again it was decided that we need to address the 'Membership Fee' before the 2010 AGM. Things will be looked at for/at the next meeting.

4. TT Courses for 2011

- With the possibility of not getting the use of WOTG (H2.5/20) for 2011. We are looking at a few 'road' courses. A few were suggested:
 - 1. Finmere 10 – N15/10 (A5 Rangers currently use this course)
 - 2. Chesterton 10 – HCC 260 (Oxonian? currently use this course)
 - 3. Ambrosden 10 (OW has been looking at this/riding it. Wait for feedback).

5. Club kit: New order

- It was agreed that we could order more stock, as long as the funds were available.

6. Stuart King memorial ride

- It was agreed that we arrange for a ride to take place in November 2010.
